



TOWN OF ORRINGTON  
*Selectmen's Meeting Minutes*  
*April 22, 2013*

*Call Selectmen's Meeting to Order:* The regular meeting of the Board of Selectmen was called to order at 7:00 PM. Those present were; Chairman, Kevin Allcroft, Howard Grover, James Goody, Terrence Bladen; Town Manager, Paul White; Town Clerk, Susan Carson; Public Works Foreman, Brian Stoyell; Rep. Dick Campbell; 2 citizens. Selectperson, Christine Lavoie was late arriving for personal reasons.

- 1. Adjustments to the Agenda:* None.
- 2. Public Comments:* Rep. Dick Campbell presents the Board with updated Old Home Week events. He states that the beginning weekend will be kicked off with a parade that looks to be the biggest Orrington has ever had. He presents the Board with the events flyer and copies of miscellaneous mailings they will be sending residents. They would like to get a large banner to hang across Rt. 15 announcing the event. Consideration is being made to have some small signs on an area of Rt. 15 near the Brewer Town line that has a small turnout area that list the events. Campbell goes over the calendar with confirmed and unconfirmed events for the week. Hoping to get surrounding communities involved as well. Requesting a \$5,000 sponsorship but will take whatever is offered. Campbell asked if there was anything else that is needed from him before he begins the advertising. Allcroft wanted to confirm that Campbell wants the Board to judge the parade floats. Campbell confirmed that, and would like them to be involved in any and all events. White asked when the funds would be needed, Campbell said as soon as possible so that they can begin mailings. Allcroft would like to see us find some funds to at least get him started. White stated he will take care of that.
- 3. Approve: Selectmen's Meeting Minutes for April 8, 2013 and Special Selectmen's Meeting of April 15, 2013:* Grover moved to approve both minutes as presented. Goody seconded. Vote: Yes-4. (Lavoie not present to vote)

8. *Reschedule Public Hearing on CMP TIF Proposed by TIF Committee:* White stated that not enough time was given to notify the public, so the hearing will be postponed until the May 13<sup>th</sup> meeting.

9. *Discussion on Road Projects for 2013-2014:* White brings the Board up to speed on what we are looking at for 2013-2014 and what is to be completed this fiscal year. Center Drive from Rt. 15 up was scheduled for overlay, however he and Public Works Foreman, Brian Stoyell would like to put that off in hopes that it can be covered by the TIF that is up for approval at Town Meeting. Ferry Road is coming apart sooner than hoped. Consideration to ditching and reclaiming to the bottom of the hill is being given to replace the Center Drive project. They are refocusing the strategy and shifting projects to save money. Goody asked if a cost estimate for Ferry Road has been done. White said he does not have that estimate yet, however he feels it will be less than the Center Drive project. Ditching needs to be fixed to divert the water, which is creating a large hole on the Ferry Road. Brewer Lake from Long Hill to the Dam Road needs to be worked on. Cross culvert has sunk. Gravel will be added where needed. Possibly extending it to the boat launch area as that corner needs work too. Fowler Road needs culvert replacement and added gravel to areas. Grover suggested holding off on that to be sure we have enough money. Richardson Road will also continue to have gravel added. We are recycling asphalt from the Snows Corner Rd project that was completed. D&H will be screening that. White is in hopes of getting some good material out of that. Grover said that Oak Hill Road needs attention as well. White stated that some of the recycled material should go there. Improvements will be made to the intersection at Snows

Corner Rd/Rt. 15 and sidewalks in the next couple of years depending on funding from Maine DOT and a grant that is in progress. Fairwind Drive is scheduled for overlay in 14-15. Fields Pond Road from sub-station to the town line will be shimmed, gravel added in 14-15 and will need to have culvert work done during for 13-14 due to a collapsing culvert. White presented the Board with a list of additional projects for the next couple of years.

10. *Treasurer's Warrants and Budget Summary:* Passed around and signed.

11. *Report Folder:* Passed around.

12. *Town Manager's Report:* None.

13. *Board Comments:* Goody mentioned Milford's salt/sand mix. He wondered if it was being forced, or if they wanted to go with that mix. Stoyell clarified. Allcroft passed a donation request from MPBN for \$100 to White that he received in the mail.

14. *Adjourn:* Bladen moved to adjourn at 8:30. Goody seconded. Vote: Yes-5.
