



**TOWN OF ORRINGTON**  
**SELECTMEN'S MEETING MINUTES**  
**NOVEMBER 12, 2013**

***Call Selectmen's Meeting to Order:*** The regular meeting of the Board of Selectmen was called to order at 7:00 PM. Those present were; Christine Lavoie, Howard Grover, Terrance Bladen; Town Manager, Paul White; Town Clerk, Susan Carson; 5 citizens. Kevin Allcroft and James Goody had previously informed White that they would not be able to make the meeting tonight. Bladen moved to appoint Grover as Chairman for this meeting. Lavoie seconded. Vote: Yes-3.

***1. Adjustments to the Agenda: None***

***2. Public Comments:*** Donna Golding noted that Long Hill Rd/Brewer Lake Rd intersection has a stop sign on both sides of the road. She suggested Johnson Mill Rd/Dow Rd should have the same sign placement. White said he would take that under advisement. The issue at hand is the alignment of the intersection. Golding thought a sign on the left side of the Johnson Mill Rd would be more noticeable. White stated that it would have to be placed right next to the road and a plow truck will take it out as soon as the roads start being plowed for winter. Sharon Caron asked if the road project on Ferry Rd was going to be split 50/50 with the State. White confirmed and said we used our contractor

***7. Update on Road Projects:*** Paving has been completed on Brewer Lake Road and Fowler Road. Overlay will take place in the spring.

***8. Update date on Clean-up weekends concerns:*** White has been in contact with DEP and has been working at a resolve in regards to the burn pile at Public Works. He has been informed by DEP that we need to be a licensed facility in order to collect and burn debris on site. Testing of the soil would have to be done as well as testing ash after burn.

**A neighboring community was fined approximately \$40,000 for having an unauthorized burn/collection site. White suggested residents contact Gary Pomeroy**

**Logging, Inc. to take brush for disposal. White assured the Board that he is still working to come to a resolve. Grover asked if everything else that is collected at cleanup weekends is acceptable, with the large dumpsters we use. White informed him that it is not acceptable. We are in violation in collecting anything at all.**

**14. Board Comments: Bladen would like to see a sign at Public Works saying no dumping and giving information to the residents as far as options. White said he was informed not to shut off residents completely all at once. Bladen said he would not like having a fine of \$40,000. White assured him he has the situation under control. Lavoie noted a gate purchase in the warrant. White said it was for the Grant Road to close off access to the Town's property.**
